

Terms and Conditions Powerade Fresh Choice All Blacks Promotion

Promotional period and eligibility

1. The promoter of this promotion is Wholesale Distributors Limited (trading as FreshChoice supermarkets), 80 Favona Road, Mangere, Auckland 2024 ("**Promoter**"). The prize provider of this promotion is Coca-Cola Europacific Partners New Zealand Limited (CCEP).
2. This Promotion runs from 14.09.2026 to 11.10.2026 ("**Promotional Period**").
3. This promotion is open to New Zealand residents aged 18 years or older who shop in-store (only) at FreshChoice (excluding SuperValue stores). Employees of the Promoter are not eligible to participate in this promotion.

Prizes

The following terms apply to the Prizes:

- (i) There are fifteen (15) Prize packs to be won that will be awarded at the end of the Promotional period.
- (ii) Each prize consists of an All Blacks scarf, an All Blacks replica rugby ball and an All Blacks jersey, size large (**Prize**). RRP NZD\$295, total Prize pool NZD\$4,425.
- (iii) All colours and sizes are final and cannot be chosen.
- (iv) In the event that any product making up the Prize cannot be obtained, despite the Promoter's reasonable endeavours to procure it, the Promoter reserves the right to substitute a different product of equal or greater value.
- (v) The All Blacks prize pack will be sent via courier in New Zealand to the winner's address once the winner has been verified and a residential address has been supplied. Each winner should allow up to 14 days from the date of the prize draw for delivery of their Prize.
- (vi) The Promoter will not be liable to any person for any damage caused to the Prize, or if the Prize is lost or goes missing, after it is dispatched for delivery to the winner.
- (vii) The Prize is not transferable, redeemable and may not be exchanged for cash.

Method of entry

During the Promotional Period, customers are able to enter the promotion by purchasing any Powerade product from the Powerade range ("**Participating Products**") from any FreshChoice store (instore purchases only, excludes SuperValue stores). To enter, customers must provide their name and phone number directly on their original register receipt and place it into the designated entry box.
5. Entry is limited to one entry per transaction. Multiple entries are permitted during the Promotion period. The entry date is the transaction date, which must be during the Promotional Period.
6. The Prizes are not transferable, redeemable and may not be exchanged for cash.
7. The Promoter reserves the right, in its discretion, to remove products from or to introduce further products to the list of Participating Products during the Promotional Period.

Winners

8. **Prize draw** - Fifteen (15) prize winners will be determined by a random draw from all valid entries received during the promotion period before 27.10.2026. The draw will be conducted by the Promoter.
9. The Promoter will contact the winner. The winner will be notified via the contact details provided. It is up to customers to ensure that their relevant details are correct. Details can be updated by emailing the FreshChoice Customer Care team at customerinfo@freshchoice.co.nz.
10. In the event the winner cannot be contacted (that is, cannot be reached by telephone and/or does not respond to email) within five (5) working days, a winner will be redrawn on the same terms as the original draw. This process will continue until a winner is able to be contacted.

The Promoter and its related companies, employees and agencies shall not be liable for any loss, damage or personal injury suffered by any person arising directly or indirectly out of or in connection with entering this promotion or claiming/winning any prize, or availing themselves of any prize, except as required by law.
